I grew up with beets. Every summer Mother would can many quarts of beets, green beans, and wax beans. It was our winter salad once the endive grown under the tarp could not take the November cold in Ely. The beets and beans were always served with sliced onions and seasoned with salt, pepper, and an oil and apple cider vinegar vinaigrette.

Beet Salad Recipe

2 cans sliced beets, drained (save the juice for jelly making) ½ white onion, sliced
Oil and apple cider cider vinegar vinaigrette
Salt and pepper to taste





Beet Jelly Recipe (Editor's note: I have NEVER heard of beet jelly!)
3 ½ Cups beet juice Mix beet juice and Sure-gel in saucepan.
1 pkg. Sure-jel Bring to a boil and cook 1 minute.

5 Cups sugar Remove from heat; add sugar & Kool-aid 1 pkg. grape Kool-aid Boil 5 minutes; fill jars and seal
